- All membership to act in accordance with the "zero tolerance" rules contained within the constitution/operating rules document.
- Any concerns, comments, questions are to be addressed in a cooperative and supportive manner. In the event that an agreeable solution is not reached, a third party will be asked to mediate and help develop a constructive solution.
- All membership to value the decisions made by executive members and Softball B.C.
- All membership to abide by current league constitution and operating rules.
- All membership to contribute to the development and enhancement of Softball at Hyacinth.
- All membership teams to fulfill obligations to the park to the best of their ability. Including (but not limited to):
 - Work Parties/Park Improvements
 - Travel Fund Collections
 - Tournament hosting.
 - Monthly 50/50
 - Fundraisers
- All membership to keep executive informed prior to the use of the facilities and/or fields at Hyacinth Park.
 - Tournaments
 - Exhibition games
 - Practices
 - Game cancellations
 - Permits/Scheduling

Coaches/players/members that are in breach of these conditions may be subject to the following sanctions from either the executive, or the disciplinary committee:
